

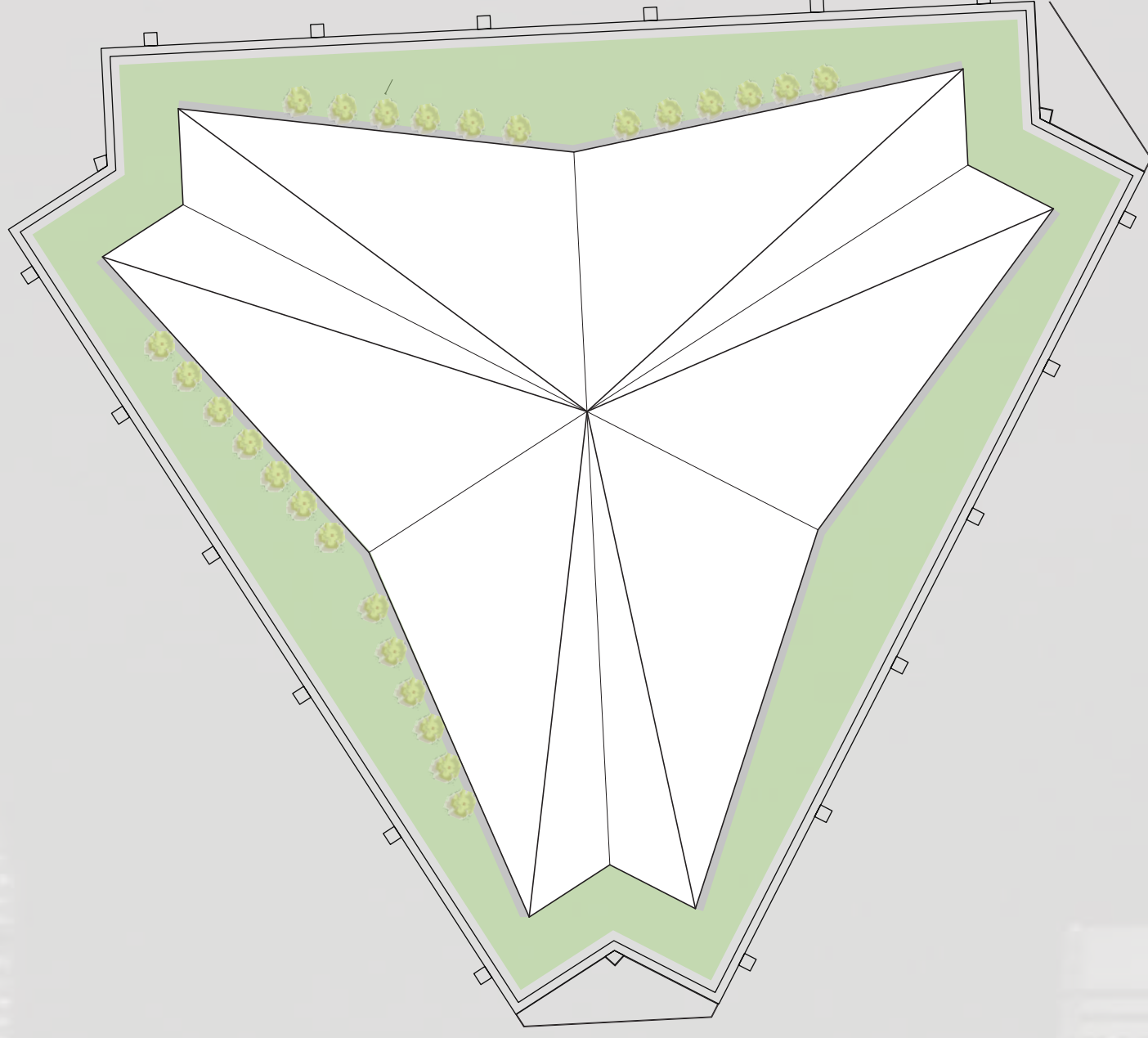
# HIGH POINT PARK

High Point Park is a multipurpose amphitheater park space which hosts a variety of events including; concerts, plays, lectures, and weddings, while simultaneously serving as a park for enjoying the expansive views of Pittsburgh.

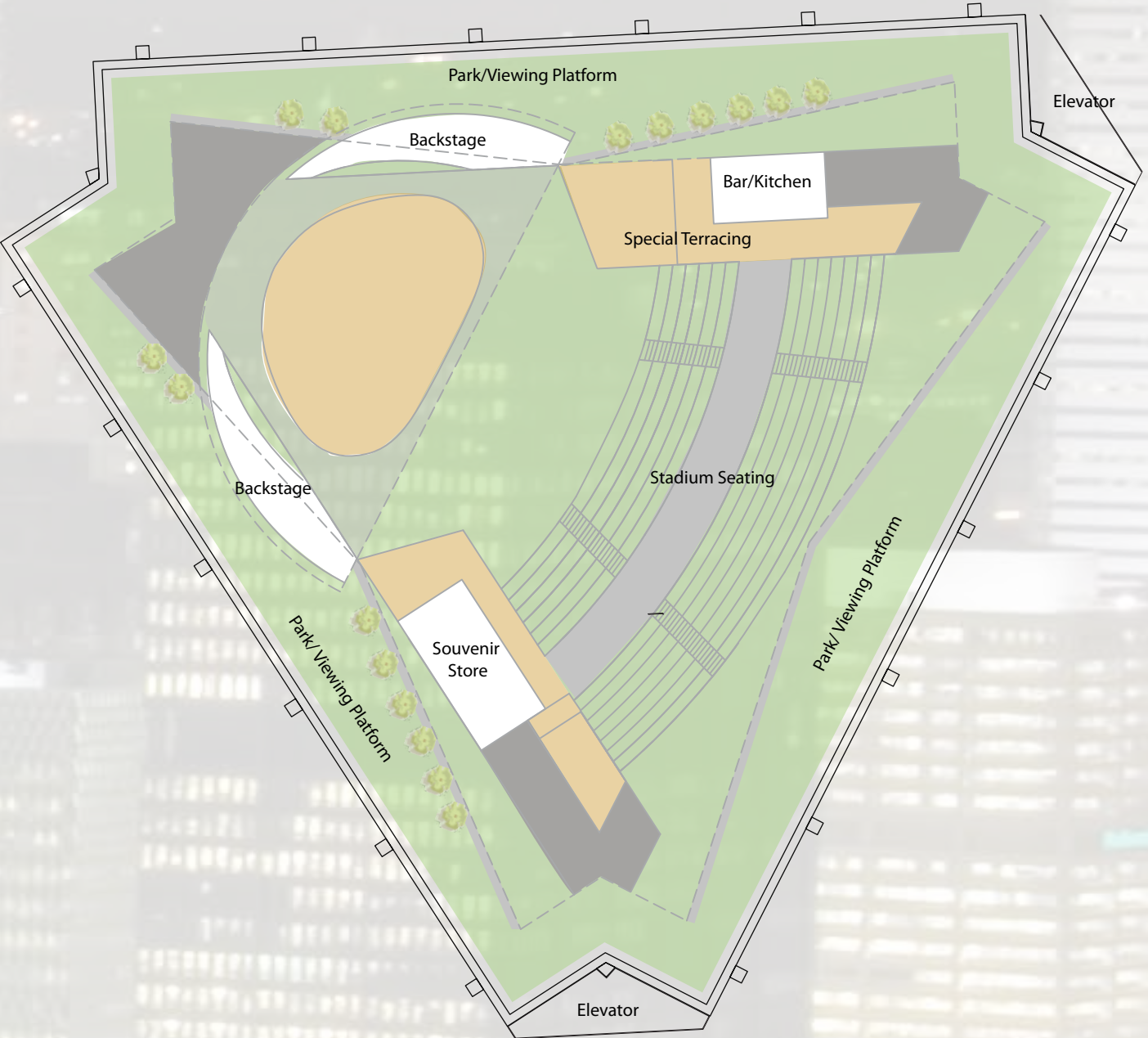
This hybrid space is formed by integrating the architectural elements of a park space and a theater. The space is composed by a stage that is surrounded with stone terraces. The terracing creates seats for the amphitheater and also supports a variety of plant life creating a lush stepping landscape. The terraced seating leads up to a viewing promenade which encircles the entire space allowing visitors to enjoy the city's panoramas. A glass and steel canopy covers the space without obscuring the views of the city. The canopy also collects rainwater which is used to irrigate all of the plants in the space. At night the canopy lights up adding a new beacon to Pittsburgh's skyline.

When the space isn't hosting an event it serves as a park space and an overlook. Access to the roof is provided by an additional elevator which is built on one of the buildings corners.

The amphitheater makes the space more than just a viewing platform allowing the High Point Park to become an exciting new event space for Pittsburgh.



Roof Plan

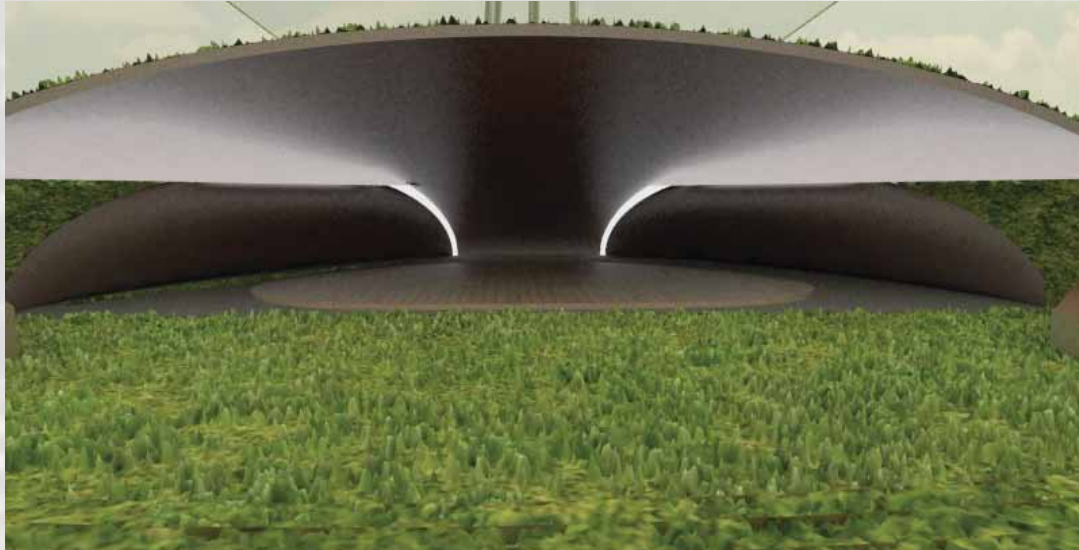


Floor Plan
