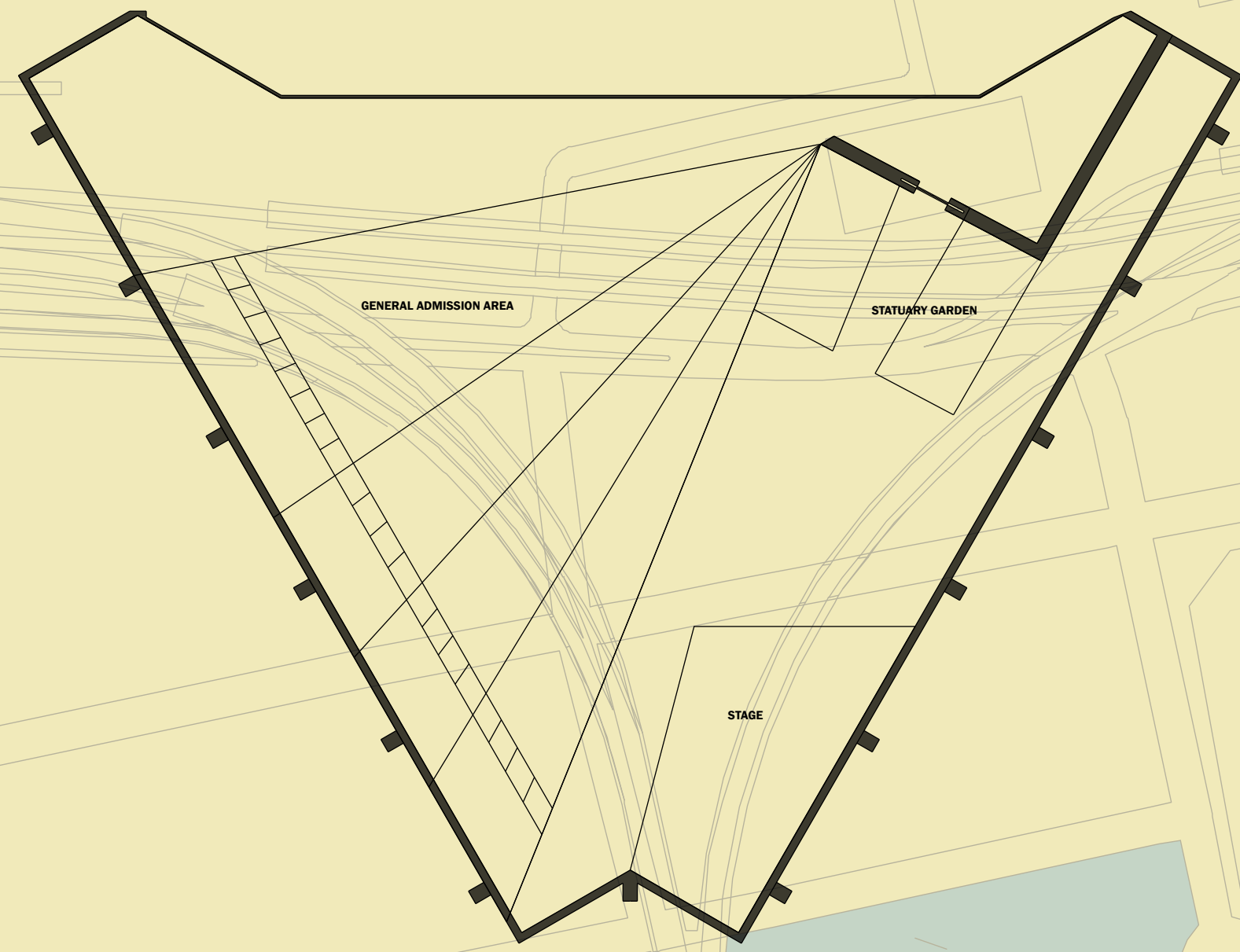


HIGH POINT PARK

PARK//GALLERY//PUBLIC VENUE

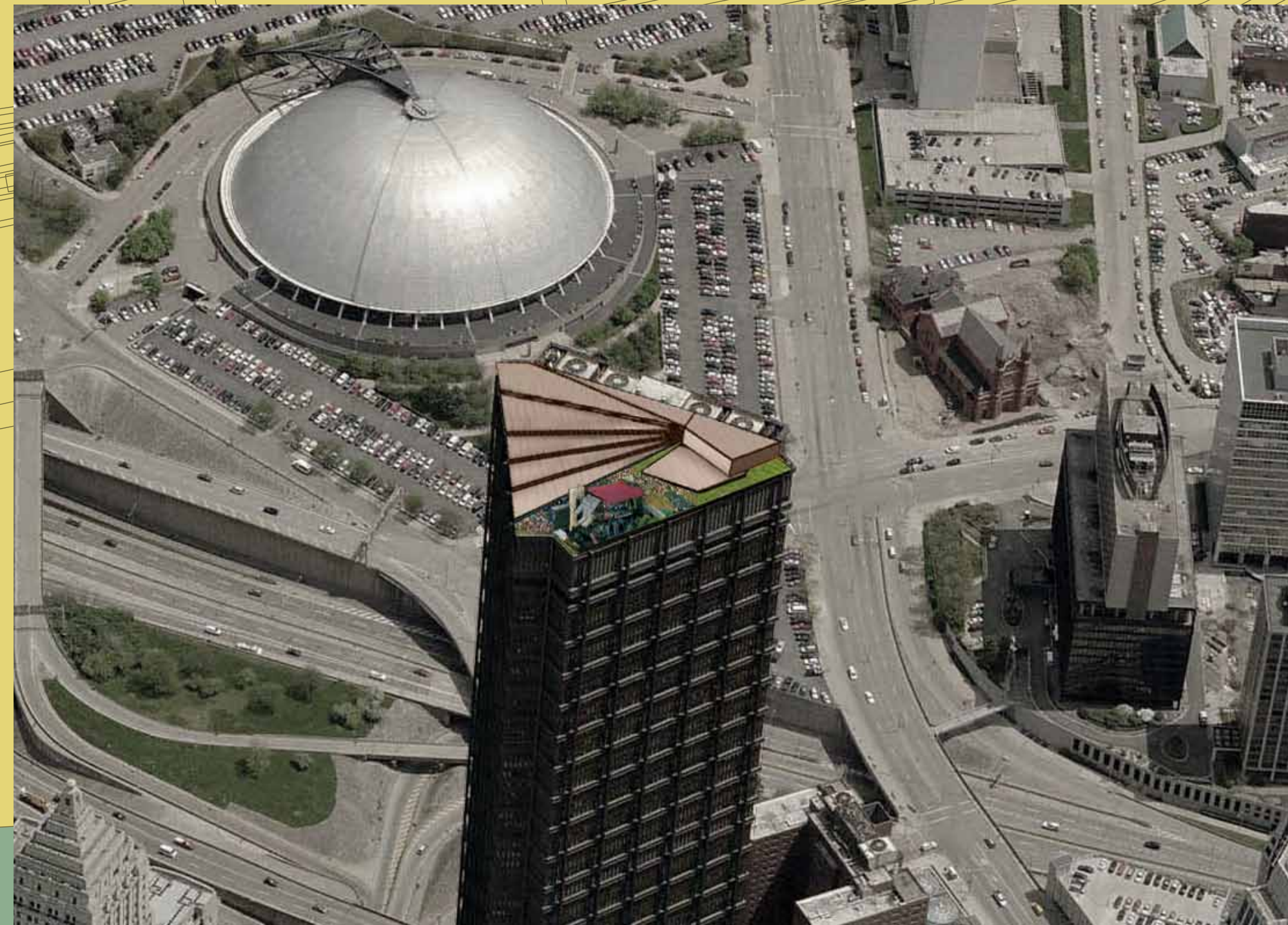
Viewing gallery/park by day and public venue by night: this proposal creates a unique experience for both a tourist seeing Pittsburgh for the first time and for a resident of the city. A visitor would have the opportunity to view the city in a matchless way while enjoying additional programs which vary by the seasons as well as day and night. The programming includes indoor and outdoor venues to be used for concerts, banquets, weddings, also a viewing gallery, a cafe, museum, all designed to attract a variety of participants. The outdoor space facilitates musicians and artists for the public to enjoy, above the distractions on Grant St, while enabling views of the city itself. This intervention transforms the building from purely business function to one that supports the arts, history, and the quality of life.

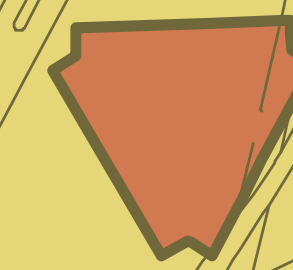
